Information About Reception of the Sacraments

The seven Sacraments of the Church were instituted by Christ to confer grace.

Sacrament of Baptism. Call the parish office to register for the parents' pre-Baptismal instruction. For adults seeking to enter the Church and be Baptized, contact our Religious Ed. Office.

Sacrament of Penance (Confession). Children in our religious education program and school are prepared for Confession at age seven, as part of First Communion preparation.

Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Children in our religious education program and school are prepared for First Communion at age seven. Adults seeking First Communion should contact our Religious Ed. Office

Sacrament of Confirmation. Young people in our parish are prepared for reception of Confirmation in the ninth grade (age 14). For adults seeking Confirmation contact our Religious Ed. Office.

Sacrament of Marriage. Couples planning for Marriage are to contact a parish priest or deacon one year in advance to set the wedding date and plan for pre-Cana instruction.

Sacrament of Holy Orders. If you believe you have, or someone you know has, a vocation to the Priesthood or Diaconate, please contact one of our parish priests.

Anointing of the Sick. For the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick (sometimes called "Last Rites") administered by a Priest, a person or immediate family member must make the request. Late night requests may not be able to be answered until the next day. For a visitation to the sick, or Holy Communion to the sick, contact our parish office.

Dear Friends,

I am so humbled to have served among you...humbled that you embraced me with so many kindnesses. A line from Shakespeare comes to mind..."I've more care to stay... than will to go..."

I want to express my gratitude to Fr. Lentini for accepting me and allowing me to minister to you good folks. I have enjoyed working by his side...bad jokes and all. He has become a good friend and I am confident that our friendship will continue beyond this time and place. As your pastor he has much on his plate...and I am not speaking of a Big Mac... pray for him. Gratitude as well to Fr. Etim. I did not know him well and have enjoyed our short time together...he is a good priest and faithful minister. It was great reconnecting with your former pastor Msgr. Dan. He and I have a long history which includes my being his vocation director. I am pleased you have been the recipients of his ministry as well. Fr. Emerson, who resides here as the Director of Spanish Ministry for the Diocese, has been of great assistance and I have appreciated our time together. Thanks as well to the Deacons of the parish...whose service goes beyond the altar yet finds its source there...thanks for the many ways you image Christ to yours truly and the parish community.

May I also express my appreciation to the staff here at Holy Cross and Immaculate Conception...you know who you are... so no names...just heaps of gratitude and admiration for all the good you do to further the Kingdom in Dover and Marydel. Whether it is office work, music ministry, Hispanic ministry, school staff and administration, religious education, youth ministry, parish outreach...yours is a special ministry rooted not only in Gospel values...but in the ways you value those in your care.

As I prepare to leave may I offer a challenge ...one that finds its source from the very Eucharist we gather to receive. You must murmur to the world you touch..."This is my body given for you.." Given for whom? Not some abstract mass called humanity. Rather for two visible sets of people...those you meet each day...and those you don't. Those you meet each day...your wife or husband ...your children...the people with whom you work and play. Here it is that you and I must continue to discover God...celebrate God...proclaim God. To bring Christ where you live and move and have your being. And "This is my body given for you..."...to those we rarely meet...the homeless and the helpless...the lonely and the loveless...the drug infested and Aids infected...all these and more... God's endless images...simply all are the Christ into whom the Eucharist transmutes you/me. Continue to be Christ's body...and your parish life will continue to thrill you and challenge you. May the Eucharistic Christ continue to feed you...lead you...bless you.

We priests are privileged beyond my poor words to describe. And in that privilege...we recognize how human we are...at times touchingly...at times irritatingly...we believe...we doubt...we hope...we despair. We need your prayers...wherever we may journey...wherever the Spirit leads.

I appreciate the offer for a reception...and my gratitude to those who helped organize it as well.

My sincere appreciation for your kind words, support, generosity and gifts. You have touched my heart and graced my life. I ask only for your continued prayers and be assured of mine.
