Additional Details

Mandatory Daily Planner: In Junior High, organization and responsibility are two important skills we teach so students are prepared for high school and beyond. Each student needs a Planner for keeping track of assignments, upcoming tests, and quizzes as well as other deadlines. Planners should be dated; specifically one with monthly calendars for long-range planning and labeled/dated weekly calendars with space available to write daily homework assignments and reminders. Students tend to willingly utilize their daily planner more consistently when they are able to choose one with a theme or color that interest and excite them. Holy Cross Planners can still be purchased from the office the first week of school for \$4

Locker Supplies: We advise purchasing a bookshelf or space divider to fit inside the lockers for organization and to protect materials from wear and tear. If a child wishes to have a combination lock on their locker, they may borrow one for the year from their homeroom teacher or purchase/use their own combination lock. The combination must be shared with the homeroom teacher prior to use.

Printers: We strongly encourage each student to have access to a printer at home and that an extra supply of printer ink is always ready.

Chromebook: If you purchased a new one, please remit \$40 for the Google Management Console license. (Payable to Holy Cross) **DO NOT LOG IN**

Labeling Materials: Only items listed in "MISCELLANEOUS" need to be labeled with your child's name.

On the **first day of school:** students are expected to have **all** of the supplies listed. Teachers meet with each class to help students set up their planners, binders, and label the dividers based on individual class needs. This process allows each teacher to lay the foundation for an organized classroom system and we do not want anyone to miss out on the benefit of teacher guidance and help.
